3. Emphasis should be on fresh plant material
4. All exhibits and extra staging, not listed in schedule, will be displayed on 6ft. tables covered in white.

DIVISION I HORTICULTURE "SEASON'S BOUNTY"

Guidelines for Horticulture Entries

1. All plant material must be fresh and must be grown by the exhibitor.
2. Exhibiting should follow NGC Handbook for Flower Shows pages 104-119
3. Entries must be correctly named, if possible with genus, species and cultivar on the entry card
4. Clear glass containers for Horticulture cut specimens must be provided by exhibitor. Arboreal specimens will be placed lying on the table.

SECTION A: ARBOREAL (Maximum length 30")

"THE HOLLY AND THE IVY"

Class 1: Conifers

- a. *Abies*
- b. *Juniperus*
- c. *Picea*
- d. *Pinus*
- e. *Taxus*
- f. Any other

Class 2: Broadleaf Evergreens

- a. *Euonymus*
- b. *Ilex*
- c. *Pyracantha*
- d. Any Other

SECTION B: CONTAINER GROWN PLANTS

"A BUCKET FULL"

- Class 1: Flowering/Fruiting (Container Maximum 10" in diameter)
- Class 2: Foliage (Container maximum 10" in Diameter)
- Class 3: Combination Plantings (Container Maximum 15" in diameter)

SECTION C: PRODUCE

"GOOD EATIN'S ON THE RANCH"

- Class 1: Fruits
Class 2: Vegetables
Class 3: Any Other



DIVISION II DESIGN "FOREST FANTASIES"

Guidelines for Design Entries

1. One design entry will be allowed per class, per exhibitor. Designs must be the creative work of the Exhibitor.
2. Some plant material, fresh and or dried must be used in every exhibit..
3. Entry card will be filled out and placed on staging by Design Chair
4. Exhibiting should follow NGC Handbook for Flower Shows pages 187-222

SECTION A: "RANCH REPASTS"

Class 1: "SOLSTICE SUPPER"

A Winter Solstice Capsule-Functional Table with decorative unit in proportion to space provided, on 1/4 or 2' width of the wooden Dining room table

Class 2: "ROMPIN' & ROPIN' ON THE RANCH"

An Exhibition Table, Type II to be displayed on a white foam core board 20" x 30", to be hung on the wall and provided by the committee

Class 3: "FOREST FIREWORKS"

New Years Evening Dinner Celebration, Capsule-Functional Table displayed on a 29" dia. round table, 30" from the floor. Provided by the Committee

SECTION B: "DECK THE LODGE, FA, LA, LA"

Class 4: "HANGING AROUND FOR THE HOLIDAYS"

Holiday Hanging arrangement to be staged on a 13" long door hook hung on door, provided by committee

Class 5: "AUTUMNAL FOREST"

A Holiday arrangement to be staged on
1. Coffee Table 36" sq. or 2., 3. & 4.
Sofa Tables 49" wide x 17" deep.
Entrant must choose staging site at time of registration

Guidelines for Educational Exhibits

2. Exhibit to occupy 18 square feet of space

Class C: "FOREST FLAME"
